CHESLYN HAY VILLAGE HALL

The Parish Council owns and manages the Village Hall site on Pinfold Lane, Cheslyn Hay, WS6 7HP. The hall is open 7 days per week for hirers (with some exceptions). The Village Hall also accommodates the Parish Council offices and Staffordshire County Council library services. CHESLYN HAY CEMETERY

The Parish Council owns and maintains a cemetery site at Cemetery Street, Cheslyn Hay, WS6 7HY, for residents of Cheslyn Hay only, which has space for both burial and cremated remains plots.

A written application can be made from outside the Parish but applicants must have a connection to the Parish and this will be subject to five times the normal burial fees.

CHESLYN HAY RECREATION GROUND AND FOOTBALL PAVILION

Cheslyn Hay Parish Council owns and maintains the recreation grounds off Low Street, Rosemary Road and Station Street which includes an under 8's play area and youth shelter off Station Street, play area and zip wires off Low Street and four football pitches and pavilion, which are hired out during the football season, off Low Street.
